Senator also discussed the importance of Alternative Energy and environment, Water issues in the area, and elderly care.

Over 40 people were present in this closed meeting where the Rotary Clubs meet to discuss the new projects they will work on. Delhi Mayor Richard Maxey and Delhi Superintendent Mark Tuthill were also present and discussed the various methods of cooperation between the towns which are represented by the Senator.
